SAN JOSE CITY TOUR

This tour immerses you in the rich Costa Rican culture and history by experiencing the beautiful museums and historical sites of San José. A drive through the beautiful Sabana Park, the historic National Theatre. Completed in 1897, the theatre is a masterpiece in art and architecture. A visit one of the many unique museums of Costa Rica. A brief stop will be made in a beautiful art craft shopping store; why not, buy souvenirs for those who are expecting you back at home.

ZIPLINE SAN JOSE DE LA MONTAÑA (CANOPY)

The canopy adventure takes travelers on an exhilarating zipline canopy tour of the treetops, in a high elevation rainforest, less than one hour from San Jose. Leap from platform to platform on the special system of steel cables with the use of professional climbing gear. The platforms are high above the forest floor, from 15 to 25 meters, (45-60 feet), and the cables range from 20 to 95 meters, (60-285 feet). This natural area is bordered by two national parks, Braulio Carrillo and Barva Volcano National Parks which serve as shelters to an abundant population of birds and wildlife.

POÁS VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK

Just 90 minutes from San Jose, visitors can look closely at the awesome power of a volcano from the edge of the main crater of the Poas Volcano. It is located at an altitude 2,708 meters above sea level, its huge main crater, Laguna Botos, nature trails and great biodiversity make this an ideal place to see a lot, in a short time place. Poas Volcano is an active volcano. In the bottom of the main crater, a lagoon rich in sulfur and acid, which upon drying intensifies the emission of sulfur and produces acid rain is formed.

IRAZÚ VOLCANO NATIONAL PARK

Just an hour's drive from San José, Irazú Volcano National Park has Costa Rica's highest volcano at 3,432 meters (11,260 feet) above sea level, and offers visitors the chance to glimpse stark and dramatic lunar landscape with vegetation that is only beginning to come back after the last violent period of activity, from 1963-65. A paved road leads right to the top of Irazú, within a few hundred feet of the principal crater with a chartreuse colored sulphur lake at its center.

ATLANTIC AERIAL TRAM



The world of trees has been virtually unexplored and inaccessible until recently. Only an hour from San Jose, the cable allows people of different ages enter the forest canopy as easily as taking a funicular. A guided walk through the forest with a naturalist introduces the rainforest and prepares it for this wonderful experience. Once aboard the funicular, you float silently through the forest from the ground level to the treetops. Lunch at the Aerial Tram and return transfer back to San Jose.

VOLCÁN POÁS / DOKA / CATARATA DE LA PAZ



On the way to the volcano we will visit the Doka Coffee Estate, where we will be treated to a coffee tour in an actual coffee plantation where we will learn the ancient techniques used by the experts to produce some of the best coffee in Costa Rica and around the world. After the coffee tour we will continue to the Poás Volcano where we will not only admire the impressive main crater with its sulfur fumaroles, but also learn about the different ecosystems in this unique and protected national park. Following the visit to the volcano we will continue to the La Paz Water Fall Garden for a scrumptious lunch and tour. You will walk through a trail, leading to a spectacular waterfall in the middle of the rainforest.

VOLCÁN POAS / DOKA / SARCHÍ / GRECIA



This tour takes us to the unforgettable Poas Volcano. At the volcano we will have time to enjoy the impressive main crater with its fumaroles. Next, after visiting the volcano, we will have time to enjoy a scrumptious lunch at Doka Estate. Our third stop is the town of Grecia, home to one of the only Metal Churches in Central America. Our last stop along the way is the town of Sarchi, known as the cradle of Costa Rican artisans. Here we will take in the artistic work of the local artisans, as they create the famous typical oxcarts.

IRAZU VOLCANO LANKESTER GARDENS AND OROSI VALLEY



At Cartago City, just hour and a half southeast of San Jose, is located Irazu Volcano, the highest volcano in Costa Rica. The road leading to the volcano, ends a few meters from the top, where the trails surrounds the main crater. After observing the volcano, you will visit the Lankester Gardens, where more than 800 species of exotic and native orchids, both stand in the middle of a fabulous collection of plants. Afterwards you will also visit the picturesque Orosi Valley, site of an old colonial settlement and one of the most important in coffee production areas. After lunch at a local restaurant, back to San Jose.

Hours: 6:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tour last, approximately 9 -10 hours **Includes:** Round trip transportation, bilingual guide, and entrance fee to Irazu Volcano National Park, entrance fee to Lankester Gardens, Orosi Valley visit and lunch. **What to bring:** Comfortable shoes and cloth, sweater, hat, sun block, umbrella, binoculars and camera and insect repellent.

TORTUGA ISLAND CATAMARAN



The day begins at your hotel The bus ride takes you to the pacific port of Puntarenas stopping along the way for Costa Rican typical breakfast. Upon arrival in Puntarenas you will board Calypso's super catamaran Manta Raya. Once underway the Manta Raya makes her way to the Gulf of Nicoya. Her white clad crew pampers guests with fresh tropical fruits and drinks. Tortuga Island is known for its immaculate white sand beach and turquoise waters, a perfect stop for safe swimming, snorkeling and Calypso's famous lunch. Once on the island, you can enjoy hiking, snorkeling, kayaking, beach volleyball or just enjoy the sun and the white sands and savour a delicious buffet served on the beach. Before nightfall, back to San Jose.

PACUARE RIVER RAFTING



Pacuare River offers some of the finest white water in Latin America, winding deep inside of one of Costa Rica's most impressive primordial rainforests. You will traverse 18 miles of remote and scenic waters that course through a wilderness of dense vegetation covering the sides of steep gorges that rise above the riverbanks. After some brief security instructions, we'll start out on this incredible rafting journey. Rafting is filled with excitement as you squeeze through narrow openings between huge boulders and run long stretches of powerful rapids.
